October 2025 BIRD NOTES

HIGHLIGHTS:

Firecrest, Mealy Redpoll, Little Owl, Gannet, Knot, Little Stint, Mediterranean Gull, Whooper Swan.

Water bird maxima were from the WeBS count on 12th unless dated otherwise. 17 Little Grebe 1st, 38 Great Crested Grebe, 1 Gannet 15th, 46 Cormorant 16th, 4 Little Egret 13th, 4 Great White Egret 19th, 8 Grey Heron 1st and 22nd, 9 Mute Swan 7th, 32 Whooper Swan 3rd, 455 Pink-footed Goose 23rd, 195 Greylag Goose, 240 Canada Goose, 1 Shelduck 15th, 16th and 20th, 68 Wigeon 5th, 33 Gadwall 20th, 450 Teal 1st, 143 Mallard, 5 Pintail 5th and 12th, 2 Shoveler 20th, 1 Red-crested Pochard 3rd, 43 Pochard 31st, 110 Tufted Duck, 22 Common Scoter 14th, 1 Goldeneye 20th, 22nd, 24th, 27th, 30th and 31st, 2 Goosander 11th and 12th, 1 Water Rail on 5 occasions this month, 6 Moorhen on 15th and 20th, 9 Coot 14th and 25th, 1 Kingfisher reported on 4 occasions.

Raptor sightings included 14 Red Kite 19th, 1 Marsh Harrier 6th, 2 Sparrowhawk 6th, 15th, 25th and 31st, 4 Buzzard 5th, 20th and 28th, 2 Kestrel on 6th and 15th, 2 Peregrine 19th and 24th.

Fifteen species of waders through this month with 1 Oystercatcher reported on 17 occasions this month, 2 Little Ringed Plover 9th, 6 Ringed Plover 8th, 16 Golden Plover 19th, 1 Grey Plover on 6 occasions, 51 Lapwing 23rd, 1 Knot 14th, 1 Little Stint 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th, 10 Dunlin 6th, 3 Snipe 28th, 1 Black-tailed Godwit reported daily from the 1st to the 8th, 2 Curlew 18th, 2 Redshank 16th, 1 Green Sandpiper 2nd and 5th, 1 Common Sandpiper 13th and 20th.

Maximum Gull numbers were 2 Mediterranean Gull 18th, 4000 Black-headed Gull 25th, 600 Common Gull 18th, 5000 Lesser Black-backed Gull 16th, 4 Herring Gull 17th and 20th, 7 Yellow-legged Gull 25th, 2 Caspian Gull 17th, 2 Great Black-backed Gull 4th and 5th, also seen 1 Common Tern 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Other species noted were 4600 Wood Pigeon 25th, 1 Little Owl 18th, 4 Tawny Owl 14th and 31st, 3 Great Spotted Woodpecker 8th and 15th, 37 Skylark 15th and 20th, 10 Swallow 15th, 100 Meadow Pipit 7th, 3 Rock Pipit 15th, 16th and 20th, 3 Grey Wagtail 12th, 50 Pied Wagtail 7th, 2 Stonechat 1st and 10th, 1 Wheatear reported on 10 dates this month 170 Fieldfare 19th, 739 Redwing 19th, 1 Cetti's Warbler on 7 occasions, 1 Blackcap also reported on 6 dates this month, 6 Chiffchaff 6th and 10th, 30 Goldcrest 31st (recorded from a perimeter count), 1 Firecrest 31st, 40 Long-tailed Tit 31st, 2 Willow Tit 6th, 46 Great Tit 31st, 12 Nuthatch 31st, 7 Treecreepers 31st, 850 Jackdaw 15th, 48 Rook 31st, 65 Carrion Crow 15th, 21 Raven 11th, 483 Starling 19th, 59 Chaffinch 24th, 2 Brambling 26th, 13 Greenfinch 31st, 97 Goldfinch 31st, 169 Siskin 31st, 30 Linnet 10th, 13th and 28th, 6 Redpoll 31st, 16 Lesser Redpoll 7th, 12 Crossbill 6th and 12th, 17 Bullfinch 31st, 16 Reed Bunting 26th.

The total 115 species noted compares to 101 in 2024, 105 in 2023, 111 in 2022, 105 in 2021, 106 in 2020. Another record breaking count for Carsington with 2022 being the next best year with 111 reported.
